INNOVATION & CARRIER WEEK EVENT REPORT

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Executive Summary

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The Great African Foundation (TGAF) played a crucial role as a co-organizer in the Innovation Week and Career Fair Day, held on August 28th and 29th, 2024, in partnership with MS TCDC. This event was designed to empower young people by providing a platform to showcase innovative ideas, network with industry professionals, and gain insights into entrepreneurship and career development.

- 5. **Continuous Learning:** Encourage continuous learning and skill development for the event organizers and volunteers.


Future Plans:
