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Executive Summary

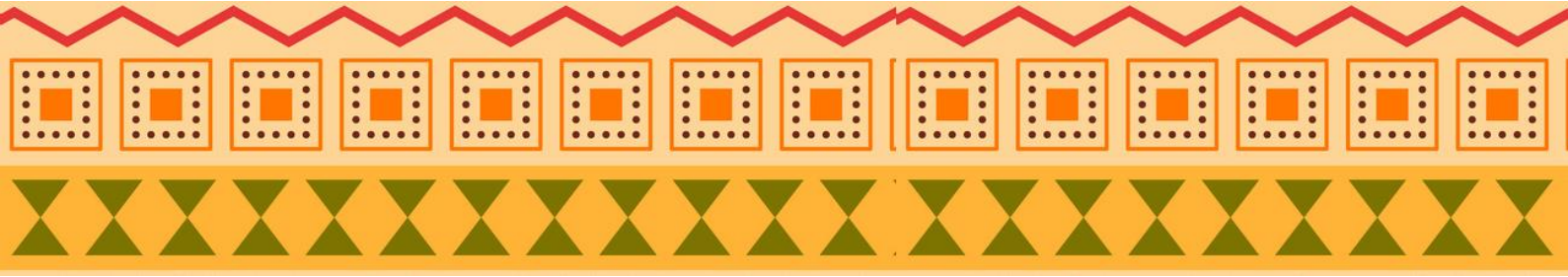

Objectives:

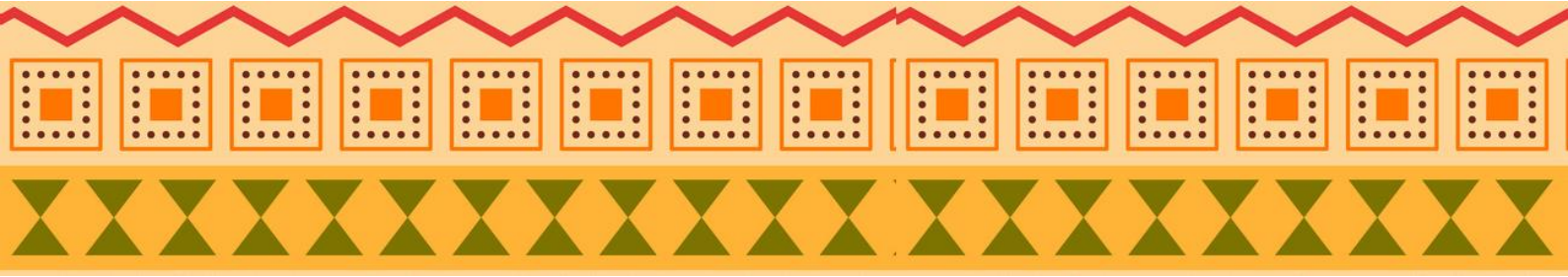
- Provide a sustainable source of income for Chanua Mtoto Center.

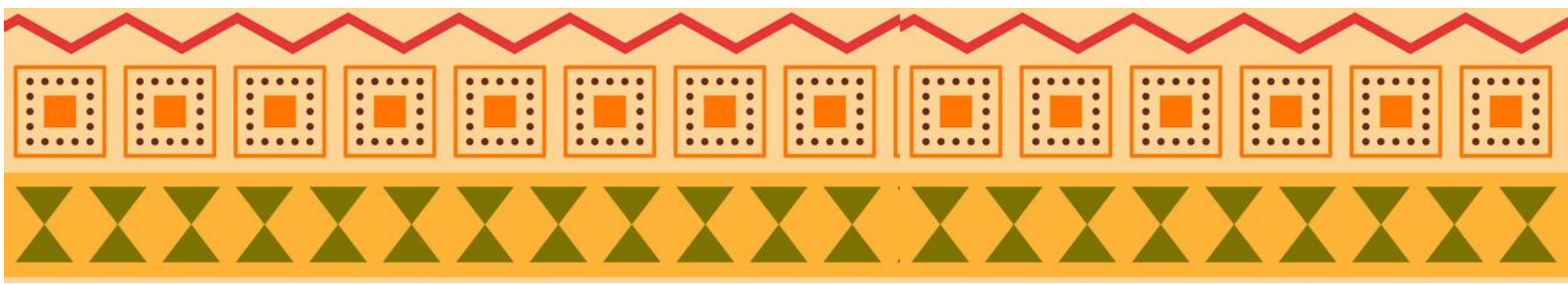
Key Objectives of the Event:

2. Knowledge and Skill Enhancement:

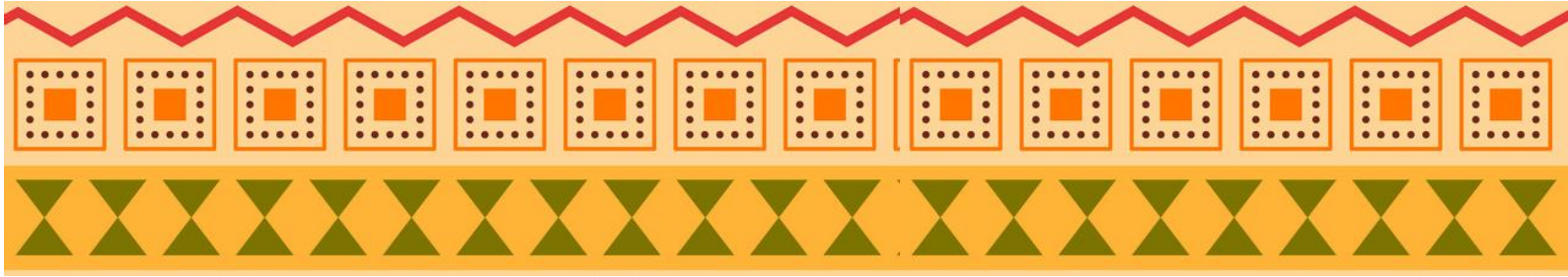

- The event facilitated discussions on potential collaborations and joint projects, which could lead to increased funding and support.



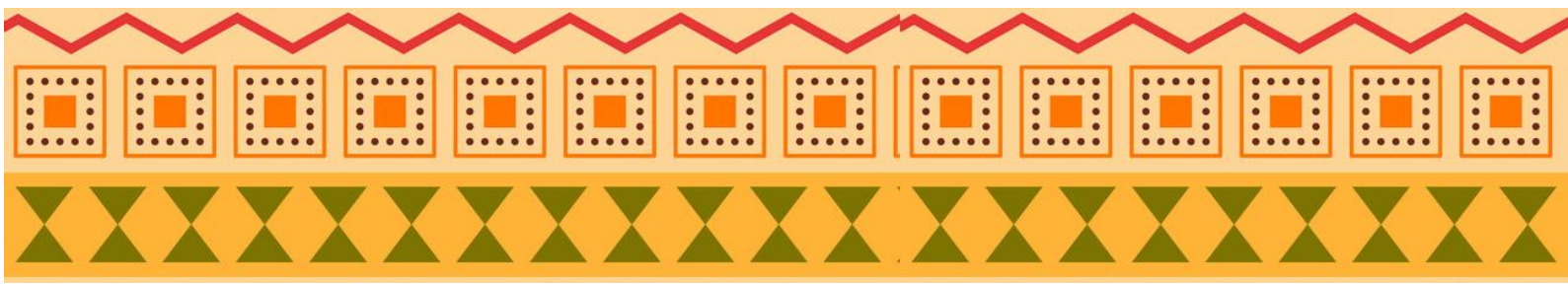
5. Enhanced Capacity Building:

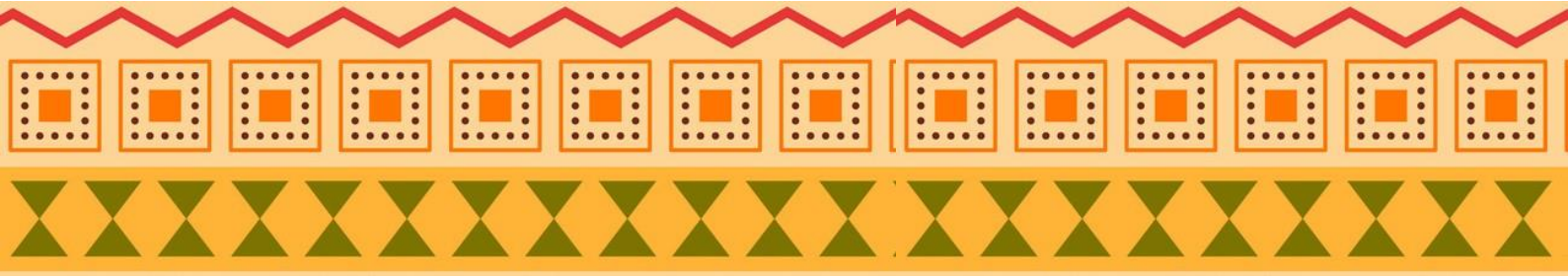
Sustainability Strategies:

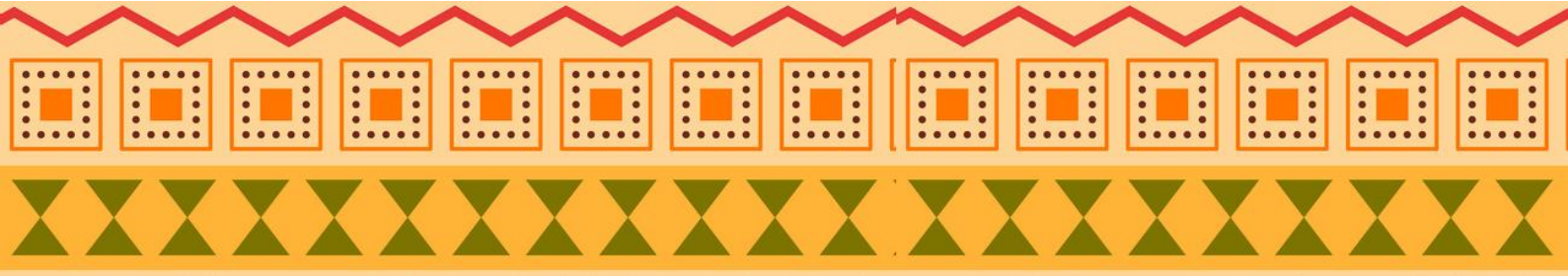
Future Plans:
